## **ABSTRACTS REQUIREMENTS**

The text of the Abstracts should highlight the statement of the issue, a brief analysis of the latest research related to the issue and on which the author relies, the formulation of the purpose and tasks of the research, an outline of the main text, conclusions, a list of used sources compiled in accordance with the requirements of the National Standard of Ukraine.

Maximum length for the abstract is approx. 2–3 pages. Abstract should be Times New Roman typeface, font size — 14, with 1.5-line spacing. Page margins should be 20 mm. Paragraph indentation — 10 mm, alignment Justify. Pages are not numbered.

On the first line in the left corner, please mention an UDC code. In the right corner — the surname and initials of the author in bold letters, then in normal letters — the course of study, the name of the study program, department and higher education institution. On the next line — the surname and initials of the research supervisor in semi-bold letters, then in normal letters — his/her scientific degree, academic title, position and place of work.

Next, the title of the article is printed in italics (centred, capitalized, bold letters). Next line — summary (2–3 lines, italic) and keywords. After one empty line is the main text of the article. Illustrative material is printed in italics.

The file with abstracts should be saved in **Microsoft Word** format and named according to the example: *Johnson G.F. abstracts*.
